- Branch staff decide literacy program(s) to offer
- Recruit for specific volunteers
 - ESL
 - Citizenship
 - Adult Basic Education
- Recruiting tutors and students
 - Posters, flyers and WOM
 - Branch staff promote and discuss program
- Online recruitment
 - Connect4Literacy
 - Volunteer Houston
 - VolunteerMatch
 - HCPL Website
- Community Outreach
 - Community Based Partnerships

- **UNITE WITH LOCAL LITERACY PROVIDERS**

- **TRAINING AND ORIENTATION**
 - Each program is a separate training
 - Trainings are 5 hours long
 - Scheduled throughout the County
 - Offer a variety of days and times
 - 5-hour trainings are group trainings
 - Offer small group or one-on-one training when necessary
 - Three areas covered in training
 - HCPL Overview
 - Volunteer responsibilities
 - Teaching methodologies
 - Get volunteers to help with training!
 - Volunteer tutors facilitate two-hour mini-workshops
- **PROJECT MANAGEMENT**
 - Onsite Literacy Coordinator
 - In-house database
 - Tracks students
 - Volunteers
 - Contact hours
 - Assessment scores
 - Statistics
 - Tutors keep daily attendance
 - Reported monthly
 - Entered into system wide report
 - Extensive Communication with Volunteers
 - E-mail, telephone, text
 - Mini-workshops
 - Provide support for materials and resources
 - Meet face-to-face
 - Staff Development
 - Bi-monthly Literacy Coordinator Meetings
 - Staff attend volunteer trainings
 - Staff coordinate the program locally
